ITEM: Consideration to approve Resolution No. 20220125.1 amending the approved budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 to repair/replace the metal awning along Harrison Avenue at City Hall for \$ 13,738.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On November 2, 2021 a downtown business delivery truck attempted to turn around on Harrison Avenue. In the process the truck struck a Gulf Power light pole and the metal awning of City Hall along Harrison Avenue – destroying the light pole and significantly damaging the awning over a large section. Insurance proceeds for the full amount of \$13,738 to repair the awning were received from the company's insurance company and deposited into the account where the funds were used to pay for the repair and replacement of the metal awning.

DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of the budget amendment in the amount of \$13,738.
