ITEM: Consideration to enter into a Subrecipient Agreement with DEO for the Hometown Revitalization Program Businesses Façade and Improvement Project and Budget Resolution No. 20220412.2.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On August 4, 2021, the City of Panama City was awarded \$4,420,697.95 for Glenwood Panama City Business Façade and Building Improvement Project through the Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO), Hometown Revitalization Program. The grant is to be used for businesses on Martin Luther King Blvd and the Glenwood area to renovate the façade of their buildings that have been damaged by Hurricane Michael. Execution of the sub-recipient agreement is required to begin program implementation.

DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of City Manager to sign the Subrecipient Agreement and approval of the budget amendment resolution.
