ORDINANCE NO. 3059

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; ESTABLISHING A LATE-NIGHT HOURS PROVISION; ESTABLISHING NEW HOURS FOR THE MONTHS OF MARCH AND APRIL; ESTABLISHING COMMERCIAL PARKING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CODIFIED; PROVIDING THAT ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT BE REPEALED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATELY EFFECTIVE DATE.
