The following conditions must be met:

1. No local or statewide burn ban is in effect.
2. Arrangements have been made with the owners of any adjoining property.
3. Burning is done under calm wind conditions (as determined by Fire Department designee).
4. Fire is under adult supervision at all times.
5. Arrangements are made for safety (water supply and/or fire extinguishers).
6. Fire is a safe distance from all other buildings, combustibles, or people.
7. The burn area or pit may not exceed 12' x 12' and material may not be stacked higher than 10' above grade level.
8. Fire is completely extinguished before leaving.
9. The Fire Chief or their designee's decision shall be final.

The Panama City Fire Department assumes no liability and the on-duty Battalion Chief reserves the right to cancel or control the burn activity at **ANY** time. The requesting party conducting the burn activity shall be liable for any damages occurring as a result of the fire. If complaints are received regarding the burn activity, the responsible party shall extinguish the fire immediately. The burn must take place on the date and times listed above or the permit becomes invalid, and a new permit will have to be issued.

Permit shall be posted at all times during the burn.
